- 1. Cuatro Strack called the Regular CDC Meeting to order at 2:00pm.
- 2. Larry Russell led the Pledge of Allegiance and Tommy Hitzfeld led the Prayer.
- 3. Cuatro Strack confirmed the presence of a quorum. Directors present were Cuatro Strack, Larry Russell, Anthony Garcia, Gary Raybon and Tommy Hitzfeld. Also present were Executive Director Carolyn Gibson, City Manager Courtney Sladek, Mayor Chris Barbee, and Councilman John Hancock. Bill Smart and Andrew Longoria, appointees to the City's Blight Committee were also present.
- 4. Public Comments: There were none.
 - At this time, any person with City Development Corporation-related business, not scheduled on the agenda, may speak to the CDC Board. In compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, the CDC Board is limited to making a statement of specific factual information in response to the inquiry, or reciting existing policy. The CDC Board may not discuss, deliberate, or take any action on any item not on this agenda. The issue may be placed on a future agenda for consideration.

- Larry Russell moved to approve Brooks Watson & Company, CPA as Auditors for the CDC Financial Audit of FYE September 30, 2021 at a cost of \$4,500. Gary Raybon seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
